# Internet Culture Black Market: An event that explores the boundaries between online and offline

The Yami-Ichi Internet was first introduced in Tokyo in 2012

Today, the Black Market of Internet Culture Yami-Ichi is open at the Central Market of Ljubljana until 2.30 pm, where "Internet products and services materialize in real space".

"Once upon a time, the Internet was supposed to be a place of 'freedom', but nowadays it is so cluttered. So we switch off, log out and jump into the real world," wrote the Aksiomi Institute, the producer of the event.

## In the freedom of exchange, creation and communication

Internet Yami - Ichi is a flea market for "browsing" face to face. "Take your internet liberties here, with us," it says in their official presentation. It was designed and presented by IDPW - a "secret society on the internet" that organizes events and parties and includes many Japanese media artists. It was created, however, when the Apple store rejected the application to the art group EXONEMO.

The idea of the app was to create an offline "black market" where they would enjoy the freedom of exchange, creation and communication that once belonged to the internet, "before surrendering to the interests of corporations and the control of political power. internet- inspired ideas, "they write at Axiom.
